NOTICE TO ALL BIDDERS AND PROPOSERS

Cone of Silence

The City of Hollywood City Commission adopted Ordinance No. <u>O-2007-05</u>, which created Section 30.15(F) imposing a Cone of Silence for certain City purchases of goods and services.

The Cone of Silence refers to limits on communications held between vendors and vendor's representatives and City elected officials, management and staff during the period in which a Formal Solicitation is open.

The following Terms and Conditions are applicable to this order entered into by and between the City of Hollywood (referred to as Buyer) and Vendor (referred to as Seller).

MODIFICATIONS

This purchase order form and any other document pertaining to this transaction which has been acknowledged in writing by the Director is a complete and exclusive statement of this order. Accordingly no modification or amendment shall be binding upon the Buyer unless signed by the Director. The City Attorney has approved these standard terms and conditions as to form and legality. Accordingly no modification of these terms and conditions shall be binding upon buyer unless they are endorsed and approved by the City Attorney. In the event of a conflict between these terms and conditions and any other document pertaining to the transaction covered by this order, these terms and conditions shall prevail.

<u>ASSIGNMENT</u>

Any assignment of this order or the performance of work hereunder, in whole or in part, is prohibited.

EXCUSABLE DELAYS

The Buyer may grant additional time for any delay or failure to perform hereunder if the delay will not adversely impact the best interests of the Buyer and is due to causes beyond the control of to Seller. Such grant must be in writing and made part of the order.

DEFAULT

In the event of default by the Seller, Buyer may procure the articles or services covered by this order from other sources and hold to Seller responsible for any excess costs occasioned thereby, in addition to all other available remedies at law or equity.

TERMINATION

Buyer, acting through its City Manager or his/her designee, reserves the right to terminate this order In whole or in part for default (a) if Seller fails to perform in accordance with any of the requirements of this order or (b) If Seller becomes insolvent or suspends any of its operations or if any petition is filed or proceeding commenced by or against Seller under any state or Federal Law relating to bankruptcy, reorganization, receivership or assignment for the benefit of creditors. Any such termination will be without liability to Buyer except for completed Items delivered and accepted by the Buyer. Seller will be liable for excess costs of re-procurement.

F.O.B.

In those cases where F.O.B. point is not Destination, Seller is required to prepay freight charges and list separately on invoice. Collect shipments will not be accepted.

TERMS

By accepting this order, the Seller agrees that payment terms shall be Net 30 unless otherwise stated.

INVOICING

TAX

A <u>mandatory</u> pre-bid meeting will be held on Tuesday March 22, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. in the Engineering and Construction Services Division (ECSD), Building "A", 1st Floor Conference Room, 1621 N. 14th Avenue, Hollywood, FL 33020. Entrance into this site is though the guard gate.

SCHEDULE:

This project shall be completed within sixty (180) calendar days of issuance of the Notice-to-Proceed.

INSURANCE:

The Contractor shall provide insurance certificates in accordance with the requirements/limits listed in **Exhibit "A"**.

BOND:

A bid bond is required for this project. The bidder shall complete the attached "Approved Bid Bond" Form in **Exhibit "B"**. The completed bond shall be submitted in the sealed bid package delivered to City Hall Rm 221 @ 2600 Hollywood Blvd.

The Contract will be awarded only to a Bidder, who in the opinion of the Engineer, is fully qualified to undertake the work. The City reserves the right before awarding the Contract to require a Bidder to submit such evidence of his qualifications as it may deem necessary and may consider any available evidence of his financial status, technical qualifications and other qualifications and abilities. Any one of the following causes, among others, may be considered as sufficient justification to disqualify a Bidder and reject his Bid:

- A. Submission of more than one Bid for the same work by an individual, firm, partnership or corporation under the same or different names.
- B. Evidence of collusion.
- C. Previous participation in collusive Bidding on work for the City of Hollywood, Florida.
- D. Submission of an unbalanced Bid in which the prices Bid for some items are out of proportion to the prices Bid for other items.
- E. Lack of competency. Item 4: Stucco Repair at Reuse Pump Station Building and North Generator (19) & North Electrical Building (14)

The stucco on the exterior walls of the reuse Pump Station Building (Location 19) and the North Generator & North Electrical Room (Location 14) is delaminating from the concrete. The estimate of square feet of damaged stucco to be removed and replaced with new stucco similar in texture and thickness to existing stucco is included in the revised bid form as noted in Item No. 1 of Addendum 1. See attached stucco specifications to be followed during replacement of the delaminated/damaged stucco. Prior to installation of new stucco the Contractor must meet with the City's Inspector to measure quantities of damaged stucco removed and confirm that all of the delaminated stucco had been removed.

Item 5: <u>Liquidated Damages Section Added</u>

Liquidated damages shall be paid by the CONTRACTOR to the CITY for failure to complete work on time in accordance with the following schedule:

Are the yellow generators inside Generator Rooms at Locations 14 and 18 to be painted?

Response to Question 4:

The yellow generators in the interior of North Generator Building 14 and South Generator Building 18 are <u>not</u> to be painted. Pipes to the generators are to be painted.

Question 5:

Is painting of the louvers inside the North Generator Room (location 14), Low & High Saline Filter Feed Pump Station (Location 13), and South Generator Building (Location 18) required?

Response to Question 5:

Painting of the interior louvers at locations 13, 14, and 18 is <u>not</u> required; only a very lightly pressure washing of the interior louver is required. Existing screens (many are in poor condition) shall be removed for pressure cleaning and then re-installed.

Question 6:

At Location 11 roof (Oxygen Train 3, 4, & 5), what distance from the edge of the roof at the top of the wall is to be sealed?

Response to Question 6:

Twelve (12) inches of concrete roof adjacent to the exterior wall is to be sealed. No other work is required on the roof of this structure at location 11.


