RESOLUTION NO. R-DOWNTOWN-CRA-2016-

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY ("CRA") APPOINTING FOUR (4) MEMBERS TO VACANT POSITIONS ON THE MURAL REVIEW COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, on April 4, 2012, the City Commission passed and adopted Ordinance No. O-2012-06, which amended Section 8.4 of the Zoning and Land Development regulations to set forth that the review process for Murals located in the Downtown Community Redevelopment Area's Music District would be established by the CRA Board; and

WHEREAS, on May 2, 2012, the CRA Board passed and adopted R-CRA-2012-25 establishing a Mural Review Committee which provided for the purpose and duties of the committee, the number of committee members, criteria for committee membership and the length of the term of committee members; and

WHEREAS, on June 5, 2013, the CRA Board passed and adopted R-CRA-2013-26 amending R-CRA-2012-25 to revise the purpose and duties of the Mural Review Committee, change the composition of the committee by increasing the membership from five to seven and eliminating the two alternate positions, revise the committee member categories and revise the guidelines and criteria for murals; and

WHEREAS, R-CRA-2013-26 specified that the Committee shall be composed of seven members; and

WHEREAS, the following categories shall be appointed at this time:

- One (1) member who owns commercially zoned property within the Downtown District of the CRA.
- One (1) member of the Downtown Hollywood Business Association.
- Two (2) at-large members with a substantial background in the visual arts

WHEREAS, the CRA provided notice to the public that positions are available and solicited interest forms from the community to fill the vacant positions; and

WHEREAS, the following candidates have expressed an interest and are qualified for appointment to the Mural Review Committee:
