A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A ONE YEAR ACTION PLAN AND PROJECTED USE OF FUNDS FOR FEDERAL PROGRAM YEAR 2016-2017.

WHEREAS, the City of Hollywood has been designated as an entitlement city by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, HUD has mandated that all entitlement cities submit a Consolidated Plan, including a One Year Action Plan, which governs housing and community development needs within the jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hollywood has utilized U.S. Census data, locally adopted planning documents, and its public participation process to formulate a Five Year Consolidated Plan and One Year Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, on July 16, 2014, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2014-229 which adopted a five year consolidated plan for federal program years 2014-2015 through 2018-2019; and

WHEREAS, through its citizens participation process, the Community Development Advisory Board (CDAB) has made recommendations which are reflected in the attached One Year Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, both the City Commission and the CDAB are committed to priorities which give maximum benefit to low and moderate income families, preserve the quality of the City's housing, and aid in the elimination of slum and blight; and

WHEREAS, the projected use of funds contained herein and more specifically described in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, pertain to Federal Program Year 2016-2017 for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and the Home Investment Partnership Act (HOME) Grant; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), has allocated \$1,090,177.00 of CDBG funds and \$377,358.00 of Home investment Partnership Act (HOME) funds for the City of Hollywood; and

WHEREAS, on June 8, 2016, the CDAB met to review and\_evaluate the proposed One Year Action Plan and the potential use activities eligible for funding for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 and have forwarded a recommendation of approval to the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the following activities represent the recommendations of the CDAB for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 which will be subject to City Commission approval after a public hearing process:
