The City of Hollywood is piggybacking through the Broward Sheriff's Office Bid Number 13104030, Outfitting Police Vehicles, as per the City of Hollywood Purchasing Ordinance Section 38.40 (C) (5) allows procurement without formal procedures, all goods and services which are subject of contracts with the state, its political subdivisions, the United States government, other governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof, provided however, the goods and services are: (i) the

subject of a price schedule negotiated by the state or the United States government, or (ii) the subject of a contract with another governmental entity or corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof, which is based strictly on competitive bids or competitive proposals and not any preference.

The initial terms of the bid were a two (2) year period with two (2) additional one (1) year renewal options. On August 12, 2013 the Broward Sherriff's Office awarded the initial two (2) year period. In July 2015, the Broward Sherriff's Office renewed the first one (1) year renewal period.
