A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO ISSUE THE ATTACHED REVISED BLANKET PURCHASE ORDER BETWEEN NICE & SMOOTH LANDSCAPE CORPORATION AND THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, TO PROVIDE GROUNDS MAINTENANCE BY INCREASING THE ESTIMATED ANNUAL EXPENDITURE OF \$94,150.00 TO \$145,273.00 FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE SECOND YEAR OF THE INITIAL THREE YEAR CONTRACT PERIOD, AND FROM \$145,273.00 TO \$167,728.00 FOR THE THIRD YEAR OF THE INITIAL THREE YEAR CONTRACT PERIOD.

Explanation:

This Resolution seeks authorization for the appropriate City Officials to issue the attached revised blanket purchase order to Nice & Smooth Landscape Corporation and to increase the annual estimated expenditure from \$94,150.00 to \$145,273.00 for the remainder of year two (2) of initial three (3) year contract and increase year three (3) of the initial three (3) year contract to an estimated annual expenditure of \$167,728.00.

On June 18, 2014, the City Commission approved Resolution R-2014-170, authorizing the issuance of Blanket Purchase Orders with four (4) local vendors which included purchase order number B002617 to Nice & Smooth Landscape Corporation for

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Grounds Maintenance service for an initial three (3) year period. As part of the agreement additional services have been identified such as debris removal, sod preparation, plant and shrub installations which requires additional funding for the Department's continual operations.

Based on an analysis of the current expenditures and the proposed items to continue throughout the Fiscal Year 2016, the Department of Public Works is requesting to increase the annual estimated amount of \$51,123.00 to an estimated annual expenditure of \$145,273.00. The Department is also requesting to increase the estimated expenditure for year three (3), the final year of the initial contract term, to \$167,728.00 for Fiscal Year 2017 with the term of the contract ending June 30, 2017.
