A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO ACCEPT 2016 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS MANAGED BY THE BROWARD COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE IN ORDER TO PURCHASE A MOBILE TWO CAMERA SYSTEM LICENSE PLATE READER TRAILER AND THREE TABLETS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$53,976.00; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL APPLICABLE GRANT DOCUMENTS AND AGREEMENTS; AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET (R-2016-284) FOR THE POLICE GRANTS FUND (FUND 13), REVISING OPERATING REVENUES, AUTHORIZING BUDGETARY ADJUSTMENTS, EXPENDITURES, AND TRANSFERS AS DETAILED IN EXHIBIT 1; AND AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL SERVICES TO ESTABLISH ACCOUNT(S) AS MAY BE NEEDED.

WHEREAS, the Broward County Sheriff's Office, on behalf of every Law Enforcement Agency in Broward County, has applied for and has been granted grant funds under the Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program funding provided by the U.S. Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, as the local facilitating Law Enforcement Agency, the Broward County Sheriff's Office is required to distribute Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program grant funds to each Local Law Enforcement Agency; and

WHEREAS, the distribution amount to each local Law Enforcement Agency is predicated upon the population and crime statistics for each jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the distribution amount for the City of Hollywood is approximately \$53,976.00 (which includes an administrative fee of 7.23% payable to the Broward Sheriff's Office), and said grant funds must be used to purchase a mobile two camera system license plate reader trailer and three tablets to be utilized by the Domestic Violence Unit and Crime Analysts; and

WHEREAS, the new mobile two camera system license plate reader trailer and tablets will enhance the efficiency and effectiveness of the Department's Offender Based Domestic Violence Reduction Initiative and Auto Theft Programs, as well as assist the Crime Analysts in developing geo-fencing opportunities within

identified geographical hot spot locations based upon the data analytics obtained from the equipment; and

WHEREAS, the acceptance of said grant funds does not require a contribution of matching funds and will incur no cost to the taxpayers of the City of Hollywood; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police recommends the appropriate City Officials accept the 2016 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program grant funds from the U.S. Department of Justice in an amount not to exceed \$53,976.00, in order to purchase a mobile two camera system license plate reader trailer and three tablets, and further authorizing the appropriate City Officials to execute any and all applicable grant documents and Agreements; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of a mobile two camera system license plate reader trailer and three tablets will be facilitated in accordance with the City's Purchasing Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Financial Services is hereby authorized to create certain accounts and to recognize revenue and appropriate grant funding as detailed in the attached Exhibit 1;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That it hereby approves and authorizes the appropriate City Officials to accept the 2016 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) grant funds managed by the Broward Sheriff's Office in an amount not to exceed \$53,976.00.

Section 2: That it hereby approves and authorizes the appropriate City Officials to execute any and all grant documents and agreements upon receiving said grant funds, together with such nonmaterial changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That it hereby authorizes the Department of Financial Services to create certain accounts to recognize revenue and appropriate program funding.

Section 4: That the Amendments, Adjustments and Transfers to the Operating Budget of the City of Hollywood for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2016, relating to the Police Grants Fund, Fund 13, as set forth in detail in Exhibit 1, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof are hereby approved, adopted and accepted as Amendments to the Operating Budget of the City of Hollywood, Florida for the Fiscal Year 2017 and the identified funds therein.
