A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, COMMITTING FUNDING TO THE JOHNSON STREET, 31ST COURT TO COMPLETE STREETS **PROJECT** AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED LETTER SETTING FORTH THE CITY'S COMMITMENT TO THE PROJECT PURSUANT TO THE FUNDING SCHEDULE FOR THE RIGHT OF WAY ACQUISITION PORTION OF THE PROJECT WITH AN ESTIMATED COST OF SIX MILLION (\$6M) DOLLARS OVER A THREE YEAR PERIOD.

WHEREAS, the Broward County Metropolitan Planning Organization (Broward MPO), the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), and the City of Hollywood are committed to improving alternative modes of transportation and support Complete Streets Corridors providing safe choices to pedestrians, cyclists, transit riders and motorists; and

WHEREAS, the Broward MPO has allocated attributable funds for the reconstruction of Johnson Street from 31st Court to US1 as part of it Transportation Mobility initiative; the Broward MPO funding is for the design and construction of the project which is currently estimated at \$13M; and

WHEREAS, a typical local street with two way traffic, swales for drainage and sidewalks has a 50' right of way; Johnson Street east of I-95 has segments with 40' and 45' feet wide right of ways, is an alternate to Hollywood Boulevard with its two lanes of traffic and continuous center lane cross section and is heavily used by pedestrians and bicyclists without the benefit of sidewalks or bike lanes for a majority of the segment; and

WHEREAS, the Broward MPO and FDOT require the City to fund the right of way acquisitions with an estimated cost of Six (\$6M) Million Dollars over a three year period to develop this Complete Streets project; and

WHEREAS, in order to minimize acquisition costs and impacts to property, the existing 40' foot segment from 28th Avenue to 22nd Avenue will be developed as a 42' foot cross section with Sharrow Bike Lanes; and

WHEREAS, in the FY 2016 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP), the City allocated \$1,150,000.00 to this project, and an additional \$1,265,000.00 was allocated in the FY 2017 CIP, for a total available funding of \$2,415,000.00; and

WHEREAS, in order to start the design for the project and property acquisition, FDOT and the Broward MPO require the City to commit in writing to funding the cost of the right of way acquisition, leading to the 2021 construction start date with the understanding that in the event that the City does not provide funding for the right-of-way funding tasks, the project will be removed from the FDOT's work program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1:</u> That it hereby approves and authorizes the City Manager to execute the attached commitment letter to the Florida Department of Transportation for the Johnson Street Complete Street project.

Section 2: That, as this project is a multi-year funded program, the City, to the extent permitted by law, will make its best efforts to fund this project for the FY 2018 and FY 2019 Capital Improvement Plan Budgets.

<u>Section 3:</u> That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
