Project Description: Johnson Street from North 31st Court to US-1

This letter is to confirm a commitment by the City of Hollywood to provide program funding for the right-of-way program tasks for the Johnson Street Complete Streets Project No. 434672-1-52-01 based upon the schedule attached as Exhibit "A." Please note that the City allocated funding in the amount of \$1,150,000.00 for this project in its FY 2016 Capital Improvement Plan, and an additional funding allocation in the amount of \$1,265,000.00 has been placed in the FY 2017 Capital Improvement Plan for a total available funding of \$2,415,000.00. This understanding will be further formalized in a Locally Funded Agreement provided by FDOT which will be presented to the City Commission prior to April, 2017. As this is a multi-year funded program, the City, to the extent permitted by law, will make its best efforts to fund this project for the FY 2018 and FY 2019 Capital Improvement Plan Budgets. In the event that the City does not provide funding for the right-of-way program tasks, it is understood that the project will be removed from the Department's Work Program.
