- 1) Department/Division involved Public Utilities
- 2) Type of Agreement Blanket Purchase Order (Sole Source No. NTSS-007-17)
- 3) Method of Procurement (RFP, bid, etc.) Section 38.40(C)(3) of the City's Purchasing Ordinance provides that, **sole-source** supplies and services, such as unique, patented, or franchised supplies or services, are exempt if the Director determines, after conducting a good faith review of available sources, that the particular supply or service is available form only one source.
- 4) Term of Contract
  - a) initial three (3) years
  - b) renewals (if any) n/a
  - c) who exercises option to renew n/a
- 5) Contract Amount In an estimated annual amount of \$109,000.00 (for a total estimated aggregate amount of \$327,000).
- 6) Termination Rights Either party may terminate for cause.
- 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements Contractor shall comply with applicable City requirements.
- 8) Scope of Services Contractor shall supply antiscalant for the membrane treatment process to ensure that the removed, dissolved solids do not plate out onto the surface of membranes making the membranes ineffective.
- 9) Other Significant Provisions n/a
