RESOLUTION NO. 1-83-75

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DIVISION TO CONTINUE TO ASSIST HOLLYWOOD HOUSING AUTHORITY AS SET FORTH HEREIN

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Hollywood, via Resolution No. R-82-94, determined that it was in the public interest and in support of the general welfare of the City to fund the Hollywood Housing Authority during its transitional stage; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable for certain City departments to continue to assist the Hollywood Housing Authority on a limited basis as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD:

 $\underline{\text{Section 1:}} \quad \text{Community Development is hereby authorized}$ to provide necessary technical and administrative services on an "as needed" basis to the Hollywood Housing Authority.

Section 2: The Hollywood Housing Authority is hereby authorized to utilize the gasoline pumps at the City's garages for the maintenance of vehicles owned by the Authority in addition to the continued privilege of purchasing office supplies and equipment through the City's purchasing department and central supply. All costs incurred by the Authority with respect to the foregoing shall be paid for by the Hollywood Housing Authority.

Section 3: The employees of the Hollywood Housing Authority are hereby authorized to participate in the City's Health Care and Insurance Plan. Any cost incurred for participating in this Plan will be paid for by the Hollywood Housing Authority.

Section 4: This authorization shall cease in twelve (12) months from date of enactment unless said authorization is

specifically extended by the City Commission.

 $\underline{\text{Section 5}} \colon \text{ This resolution shall be in full force and}$ effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
