The City is piggybacking through the City of Margate, Florida, acting as the lead agency for the Southeast Florida Governmental Purchasing Co-op, awarded its Bid Number 2017-008 for the purchase of Sodium Hydroxide to Allied Universal Corporation of Miami, Florida, for an initial term of one (1) year with an option to renew for two (2) additional one (1) year periods. Section 38.46 of the City of Hollywood's Purchasing Ordinance provides that the Director shall have the authority to join with other governmental
