WHEREAS, on June 4, 2014, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2014-135 which authorized the execution of a Reciprocal Use Agreement for a three (3) year term which expires on June 11, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into a new agreement in order to continue the use of each other's facilities to provide both municipal and educational programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That it hereby approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City Officials, of the attached reciprocal use agreement between the City and the School Board of Broward County, together with such non-material changes as may subsequently be agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.
