WHEREAS, there is one (1) existing vacancy in the Member category position due to the removal of Julia Yaremchuk and her term expires June 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Ryan Sherota's and Max Wiederhorn's terms in the Student Alternate Member category expire June 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk provided notice to the public that positions were available and solicited interest forms from citizens to fill available vacancies; and

WHEREAS, City staff provided notice to principals of Hollywood schools that two (2) Student Alternate members positions are available; and
