**Linda-Lou White** has worked as an Entertainment Provider and Event Producer for more than 25 years. Her career commenced with a live music club in Miami's South Beach. She co-founded the South Florida Blues Society and served as Entertainment director of the esteemed Art Deco Weekend festivals.

White became a Florida licensed talent agent in 1996. Her company, The Talent & Entertainment Company of Florida (T&E), booked, managed and produced hundreds of special events throughout the Southeast US, Mexico and Caribbean. Clients were Fortune 500 companies as well as national Meeting and Event Planners. (T&E) had offices in Miami Beach, Hollywood, and Royal Palm Beach, Florida. Performers included national, regional and local entertainment - from The Beach Boys to skydivers to alligator wrestlers! And a wide variety of venues – from Disney to the Mar Lago Trump mansion, to neighborhood festivals and parades.

In 2005, **White** purchased a 2<sup>nd</sup> home in Bay St Louis, MS. Days later, this small arts town became Ground Zero for Hurricane Katrina. Although venues were destroyed and artists displaced, **White** remained in Bay St Louis and established **Music South Inc.** She volunteered time, meeting space and expertise, becoming a resource and active supporter of the arts community. **Music South** provided entertainment for local festivals such "Bridgefest" and "Puttin' on the Roux" as well as the BSL Little Theatre and Mississippi Blues Trail "Juke Joint" 100 Men Hall.

During her 6-year residence in Mississippi, **White** served on non-profit Boards of the Arts-Hancock County, Bay St Louis Little Theatre, Alice Moseley Folk Art Museum and Bay-Waveland Main Street. Hancock County Chamber of Commerce named her an Outstanding Citizen of Hancock County (2008) . Drawing from her experience in historic preservation in the Art Deco District (South Beach) she served on the Historic Preservation Commission of Bay St Louis and personally developed 6 properties in the historic Depot District of the city.

With "mission accomplished", **White** returned to South Florida; she re-connected with friends and artists. Her "semi-retirement" goal became mentoring artists and producing private concerts showcasing under-represented talent. In 2015, she acquired and renovated a property in Hollywood where she resides and plans events for the 2017-18 season.
