Florida Building Code and 157.21 Hollywood Ordinance UNSAFE DWELLINGS, HOTELS, OR ROOMING HOUSES

2. What is the difference between unsightly and unsafe?

Unsightly under the City of Hollywood ordinance below regarding what is an unsightly property but and unsafe property is different in that it the mission is to protect the public.

§ 157.01 PURPOSE; SCOPE.

The purpose of this chapter is to establish uniform minimum standards for the occupancy and maintenance of dwellings, hotels, rooming houses, and commercial, industrial and institutional structures located in the city. The objectives of this code are to improve, preserve and maintain the buildings and structures of the city and to eliminate the blighting influences thereto. Every building or structure in the city that is subject to the provisions of this code shall conform to the requirements of this code regardless of when the building or structure may have been constructed, altered or repaired. This code does not replace or modify standards of other codes or ordinances for the construction, replacement or repair of buildings, and with respect to unsafe structures, this code shall be in accordance with the Florida Building Code in effect in Broward County, as revised from time to time.

Unsafe is described here as

Safeguard the public health, safety and general welfare through structural strength, means of egress, facilities, stability, sanitation, adequate light and ventilation, energy conservation, and safety to life and property from fire and other hazards attributed to the built environment including alteration, repair, removal, demolition, use and occupancy of buildings, structures or premises, and by regulating the installation and maintenance of all electrical, gas, mechanical and plumbing systems

116.2.1 Physical Criteria. 116.2.1.1 A Building shall be deemed a fire hazard and/or unsafe when: 116.2.1.1.1 It is vacant, unguarded and open at doors or windows. 116.2.1.1.2 There is an unwarranted accumulation of dust, debris or other combustible material therein. 116.2.1.1.3 The building condition creates hazards with respect to means of egress and fire protection as provided herein for the particular occupancy. 116.2.1.2 A building shall be deemed unsafe

when: 116.2.1.2.1 There is a failure, hanging loose or loosening of any siding, block, brick, or other building material. 116.2.1.2.2 There is a deterioration of the structure or structural parts. 116.2.1.2.3 The building is partially destroyed. 116.2.1.2.4 There is an unusual sagging or leaning out of plumb of the Building or any parts of the building and such effect is caused by deterioration or overstressing. 116.2.1.2.5 The electrical or mechanical installations or systems create a hazardous condition in violation of the Standards of this Code. 116.2.1.2.6 An unsanitary condition exists by reason of inadequate or malfunctioning sanitary facilities or waste disposal systems. 116.2.1.2.7 Swimming pools that contain stagnant water are deemed unsanitary and dangerous to human life and public welfare and shall be presumed and deemed unsafe.

3. Once a notice is posted on an unsafe structure by the Building Official, how many occupants are allowed to enter the structure?

None are permitted to occupy the building

116.4 Posting. The Building Official shall post, but not before ten (10) business days after the notice of violation hereinafter provided has been served, a signed notice in a conspicuous location on the building or structure which has been determined to be unsafe. The posted notice shall read substantially as follows: "UNSAFE BUILDING." This building or structure is, in the opinion of the Building Official, unsafe, as defined in Section 116 of this Code. This Building Shall Be Vacated — **Shall Not Be Occupied**. Action shall be taken by the owner as further prescribed by written notice previously served. This Notice Shall Not Be Removed Except By The Building Official. Date _______

4. Can construction work that was commenced without a building permit be deemed unsafe?

Yes and work that is done without a permit is subject to double permit fees/fines and may have to be partially or completely demolished incurring unnecessary costs and delays.

5. What is the significance of the code requiring a citizen with experience and background in social problems to sit on the Unsafe Structures Board?

Experience as professionals in a the real estate related business is important in grasping and understanding building codes for south Florida but equally important is to understand social problems and that social justice means all citizens are entitled to the same rights. Our obligation is to help them understand why they are before us and give them our attention and consideration for their situations.
