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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY **AUTHORIZING** THE HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROPRIATE CITY **OFFICIALS** ISSUE THE TO ATTACHED BLANKET PURCHASE ORDER BETWEEN HOME DEPOT U.S.A., INC. AND THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD FOR RETAIL MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, OPERATING (MRO) SUPPLIES AND RELATED SERVICES CITY-WIDE FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL EXPENDITURE OF \$80,000.00.

WHEREAS, the City requires an agreement with a qualified vendor for the supply and delivery of retail maintenance, repair, operating (MRO) supplies and related services to all Departments, Divisions and Offices for the maintenance, repair and operation of facilities throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the required products and supplies have been competitively bid by the U.S. Communities/National Cooperative Purchasing Program on behalf of Maricopa County, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, on January 11, 2017, Home Depot U.S.A., Inc. was awarded the U.S. Communities/National Cooperative Purchasing Program Maricopa County Contract Number 16154-RFP based on Request for Proposals (RFP) number RFP Serial 16154-RFP for the supply and delivery of retail maintenance, repair, operating (MRO) supplies for an initial five (5) year term with an option to renew for one (1) additional five (5) year renewal term; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.40 (C)(5) of the Purchasing Ordinance allows the Director to procure, without following formal procedures, all goods and services which are subject of contracts with the state, its political subdivisions, the United States government, other governmental entities, or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof, provided however, the goods and services are: (i) the subject of a price schedule negotiated by the state or the United States government, or (ii) the subject of a contract with another governmental entity or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof, which contract is based strictly on competitive bids or competitive proposals and not on any preference; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Procurement and Contract Compliance has recommended that the City Commission approve the issuance of the attached blanket purchase order (B002995) to Home Depot U.S.A., Inc. for the supply and delivery of retail maintenance, repair, operating (MRO) supplies and related services City-wide for the remainder of the awarded contract's current five (5) year term, for an estimated annual expenditure of \$80,000.00; and

WHEREAS, award is subject to the City's receipt and approval of all insurance certificates required by the City's Risk Manager; and

WHEREAS, funding for this agreement has been provided in FY 2017 budget in individual departmental and office budgeted accounts and will be budgeted in subsequent fiscal years;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That it hereby approves and authorizes the issuance, by the appropriate City Officials, of the attached blanket purchase order between Home Depot U.S.A., Inc. and the City of Hollywood, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.

<u>Section 2:</u> That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
