- 3) Method of Procurement (RFP, bid, etc.) "Piggyback" exemption
- 4) Term of Contract
 - a) initial $-4\frac{1}{2}$ yrs.
 - b) renewals (if any) One 5-yr. renewal
 - c) who exercises option to renew Renewal requires approval of both parties.
- 5) Contract Amount \$80,000/yr. (est.).
- 6) Termination rights City can terminate without cause by giving 60 days' notice.
- 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements Vendor will indemnify City and provide insurance.
- 8) Scope of Services Vendor will provide maintenance, repairs, operating supplies, industrial supplies and related products and services citywide.
- 9) City's prior experience with Vendor Yes.
- 10) Other significant provisions None.
