This Resolution seeks authorization for the appropriate City Officials to issue the attached Blanket Purchase Order (BPO) to Tripp Electric Motors for the Department of Public Utilities for motor and pump repairs in an annual estimated amount of \$135,000.00.

The City of Hollywood is piggybacking the service through Martin County Bid # 2015-2780 which approved the initial term for three (3) years with two (2) additional one (1) year periods. The initial term, which this BPO covers, will expire April 14, 2018. Section 38.40 (C)(5) of the Purchasing Ordinance allows the Director to procure, without following formal procedures, all goods and services which are subject of contracts with the state, its political subdivisions, the United States government, other governmental entities, or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public Page 2 BIS 17-209 File TMP-2017-354

officers, or any combination thereof, provided however, the goods and services are: (i) the subject of a price schedule negotiated by the state or the United States government, or (ii) the subject of a contract with another governmental entity or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof, which contract is based strictly on competitive bids or competitive proposals and not on any preference.
