This Resolution seeks City Commission authorization to execute the Agreement between the City of Hollywood and the School Board of Broward County for the continuation of the School Resource Officer Program in a total of twenty-one (21) schools for the 2017-2018 school year. The term of this Agreement commences on August 14, 2017 and concludes on June 7, 2018.

The City of Hollywood will receive a total of \$508,772.00 from the Broward County School Board for the deployment of three (3) School Resource Officers in the thirteen (13) public elementary schools, seven (7) School Resource Officers in the seven (7) middle and high schools and one (1) School Resource Officer at Beachside Montessori in the City of Hollywood as referenced in the Agreement. The payment from the
