This Resolution seeks authorization to issue blanket purchase order B002995 between the City and Home Depot U.S.A., Inc. (Home Depot) for the Citywide supply of facilities maintenance, repair, and operating (MRO) supplies for the term commencing on August 1, 2017 and ending on October 31, 2021 in an estimated annual expenditure amount of \$80,000.00.

The U.S. Communities/National Cooperative Purchasing Program on behalf of Maricopa County, Arizona; competitively bid the required facility MRO supplies through RFP Serial 16154-RFP which was awarded to Home Depot for an initial five (5) year term commencing on February 1, 2017 and expiring on December 31, 2021.
