## Explanation:

This Resolution seeks authorization for the appropriate City Officials to issue the attached Blanket Purchase Order (BPO) to Polydyne, Inc. for the supply and delivery of Liquid Polymer for the Department of Public Utilities in an estimated annual expenditure of \$235,000.00.

The City of Hollywood is piggybacking the service through the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida which approved the award of Bid Number 442-11387 for Sludge Dewatering Polymer to Polydyne Inc. for an initial one (1) year period with renewal options for three (3) additional one (1) year periods. The City of Fort Lauderdale exercised the third renewal option providing a new expiration date of September 7, 2018 and Polydyne, Inc. has agreed to extend the same terms, conditions and pricing as outlined in the City of Fort Lauderdale agreement to Hollywood.
