AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 99 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES ENTITLED "MUNICIPAL BEACH" TO REVISE SECTION 99.02 SECTION(B)(4) RELATED TO THE LAUNCHING OF NON-MOTORIZED VESSELS.

WHEREAS, Chapter 99 of the Code of Ordinances establishes the Municipal Beach regulations; and

WHEREAS, Section 99.02(B)(4) currently sets forth regulations relating to the launching of non-motorized vehicles between Meade Street and Custer Street and between Bougainvillea and Azalea Terrace; and

WHEREAS, there have been requests from citizens to add a southern non-motorized launch area, and City staff has determined that the regulations as to the location for launching non-motorized vehicles should be expanded; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has reviewed the purposed amendment to Section 99.02 and has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Hollywood to amend the regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That Chapter 99 of the Code of Ordinances entitled "Municipal Beach" is hereby amended as follows:

TITLE IX: GENERAL REGULATIONS

* * *

CHAPTER 99: MUNICIPAL BEACH

* * *

§99.02 ACTIVITIES ALLOWED.

* * *

(Coding: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words underscored are additions.)

(B) The following activities are permitted at all times in the designated areas set forth herein:

* * *

(4) The launching of non-motorized vessels is permitted between Meade Street and Custer Street, and between Bougainvillea and Azalea Terrace and eastward of the beach access walkway south of 3101 South Ocean Drive and north of 3505 South Ocean Drive. For purposes of this section, non-motorized vessels include kayaks, rowboats, canoes, recreational wind powered watercraft and any non-motorized watercraft which use human physical effort as their primary source of motive power. Non-motorized vessels launched from the designated area must exit the launch area and proceed on a generally straight line east to a point 300 yards from shore where they may then operate on a north south course. Launching of motorized vessels and personal motorized watercraft is prohibited. Public safety personnel may close, or restrict the hours of, the non-motorized launch areas, depending upon bather capacity, weather or other conditions.

<u>Section 2:</u> That it is the intention of the City Commission and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance shall be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hollywood, Florida, and the sections of this Code may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.

<u>Section 3</u>: That if any word, phrase, clause, subsection or section of this ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of any remaining portions of this ordinance.

<u>Section 4</u>: That all sections or parts of sections of the Code of Ordinances, all ordinances or parts of ordinances, and all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 5</u>: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
