## **Explanation:**

This Resolution seeks authorization for the appropriate City Officials to amend Resolution R-2016-368, and execute the revised attached agreement with the Children's Services Council of Broward County (CSC) for Fiscal Year 2018 regarding the Maximizing Out of School Time (MOST) Year-Round Grant.

On December 14, 2016, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2016-368 authorizing the appropriate City Officials to apply for and if awarded, accept a tri-party agreement with Children's Service Council (CSC) of Broward County, Art and Cultural Center and the City for the 2017-2018 MOST Grant. CSC had determined the City needed to partner with a fiscal agent to qualify to receive full funding of the grant.
