A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO ACCEPT 2017 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS MANAGED BY THE BROWARD COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE IN ORDER TO PURCHASE TRAINING SIMULATOR EQUIPMENT/SOFTWARE UPGRADES. A COMPACT WET/DRY LIVESCAN TEN-PRINT SCANNER, THIRTY-SIX (36)BROTHER MOBILE **THERMAL** PRINTERS AND TWENTY (20) MAGTEK SWIPE MAGNETIC CARD READERS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$46,484.14; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL APPLICABLE GRANT DOCUMENTS AND AGREEMENTS, AND ESTABLISH CERTAIN ACCOUNTS TO RECOGNIZE AND APPROPRIATE THE GRANT FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the Broward County Sheriff's Office, on behalf of every Law Enforcement Agency in Broward County, has applied for and has been granted grant funds under the Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program funding provided to the U.S. Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, as the local facilitating Law Enforcement Agency, the Broward County Sheriff's Office is required to distribute Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program grant funds to each Local Law Enforcement Agency; and

WHEREAS, the distribution amount to each local Law Enforcement Agency is predicated upon the population and crime statistics for each jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the distribution amount for the City of Hollywood is approximately \$46,484.14 (which includes an administrative fee of 8.62% payable to the Broward Sheriff's Office), and said grant funds must be used to purchase training simulator equipment/software upgrades, a compact wet/dry Livescan ten-print scanner, thirty-six (36) Brother Mobile Thermal printers and twenty (20) MagTek Swipe magnetic card readers; and

WHEREAS, this funding globally enhances a number of the Department's technology driven efforts; and

WHEREAS, the acceptance of said grant funds does not require a contribution of matching funds and will incur no cost to the taxpayers of the City of Hollywood; and

WHEREAS, certain accounts will need to be established in the appropriate funds to recognize the receipt of grant funding and appropriate identified grant funding for grant related expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police recommends the appropriate City Officials accept the 2017 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program grant funds from the U.S. Department of Justice in an amount not to exceed \$46,484.14, in order to purchase training simulator equipment/software upgrades, a compact wet/dry Livescan ten-print scanner, thirty-six (36) Brother Mobile Thermal printers and twenty (20) MagTek Swipe magnetic card readers, and further authorizing the appropriate City Officials to execute any and all applicable grant documents and Agreements; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of training simulator equipment/software upgrades, a compact wet/dry Livescan ten-print scanner, thirty-six (36) Brother Mobile Thermal printers and twenty (20) MagTek Swipe magnetic card readers will be facilitated in accordance with the City's Purchasing Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That it hereby approves and authorizes the appropriate City Officials to accept the 2017 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) grant funds managed by the Broward Sheriff's Office in an amount not to exceed \$46,484.14.

Section 2: That it hereby approves and authorizes the appropriate City Officials to execute any and all grant documents and agreements upon receiving said grant funds, together with such nonmaterial changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That the Department of Financial Services is authorized to create and establish in the appropriate fund the necessary accounts to recognize the receipt of grant funding, and to appropriate grant related funding as may be required.

<u>Section 4</u>: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
