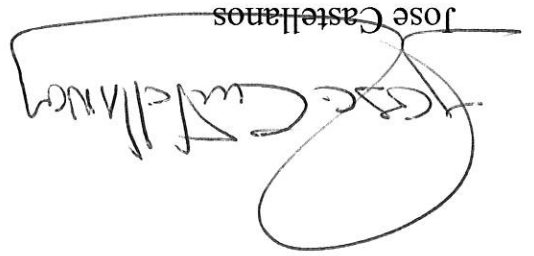


To whom it may concern,

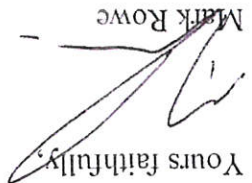
To Whom It May Concern:

We opened Mickey Byrne's Irish Pub in Downtown Hollywood in November 2008. The economy was crashing as we were in our build out and the sense of optimism that people had for our City had dissipated in the six month between our lease take over and the eventual opening of our pub. The streets were quiet, Construction projects were abandoned and stores were closing every second week. We managed to prevail.

Now almost 9 years later things are looking up. New quality businesses are opening, Construction that had been halted has resumed and the Downtown has started to look like a positive place to frequent again.

I believe The Parklet Program will be of huge benefit to Downtown Hollywood. I've been in favor of this program since it's initial suggestion a couple of years ago. Mickey Byrne's has a very limited outdoor seating area (our café permit limits us to 4 tables) and an additional seating area would be a great help to our business to facilitate our patrons who wish to dine Alfresco. 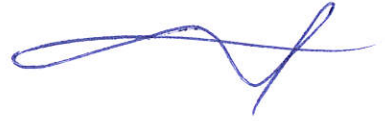
