The City and the Florida East Coast Railway (FEC) have agreements in place that require the City to maintain and replace at its expense the various railroad crossings located throughout the City. Annually, the FEC notifies the City of what locations it will be reconstructing and the estimated cost. The current reconstruction locations are Taft Street and Monroe Street with a combined cost estimate not to exceed \$237,706.06.

On October 4, 2017, the City Commission adopted R-2017-295 which continued the appropriation for previously approved Capital Projects from FY 17 to FY 18 and included funding for the FEC Railroad Crossing Maintenance.
