Explanation:

The Parking Division requires an agreement with a qualified firm to provide a comprehensive parking study on the Barrier Island and the Lakes Community.

RFP-4559-17-JE was opened at 3:00 P.M. on August 31, 2017, and resulted in a response from two (2) firms. The proposals were evaluated by a committee and ranked, and then oral interviews were conducted with both firms.

After the oral interviews, the resultant scores were compiled to arrive at the rankings, lowest score is the highest ranked as follows:

1. Walker Parking Consultants 3.0

2. Timothy Haahs & Associates 6.0

The Director of Development Services and the Director of the Procurement and Contract Compliance recommend that the City Commission authorize the negotiation

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and execution of an agreement with the highest ranked firm, to provide a Parking Study for the Barrier Island and Lakes Community in an amount not to exceed \$93,200.00.
