SUBJECT: Proposed Blanket Purchase Order with Strobes-R-US, Inc.

I have discussed the above Agreement with the participating Department/Office, and the proposed general business terms and other significant provisions are as follows:

- 1) Department/Division involved Public Works
- 2) Type of Agreement Blanket Purchase Order
- Method of Procurement (RFP, bid, etc.) Initially Section 38.40(C)(5) of the City's Purchasing Ordinance allows the Director to procure, without following formal procedures, all goods and services which are subject of contracts with the state, its political subdivisions, the United States government, other governmental entities, or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof, provided however, the goods and services are: (i) the subject of a price schedule negotiated by the state or the United States government, or (ii) the subject of a contract with another governmental entity or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof, which contract is based strictly on competitive bids or competitive proposals and not on any preference.
- 4) Term of Contract
 - a) initial One year
 - b) renewals (if any) This is a 120 day extension of the Contract
 - c) who exercises option to renew Mutual agreement of the parties
- 5) Contract Amount \$37,000.00
- 6) Termination Rights Either party may terminate for cause.
- 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements Contractor shall comply with applicable City requirements.
- 8) Scope of Services Contractor shall supply and install emergency and related equipment for law enforcement vehicles and general fleet vehicles on an as needed basis.
- 9) Other Significant Provisions Competitively bid by the Broward Sheriff's Office Bid No. 13104030.
