On July 3, 2017, the City Commission approved R-2017-200, authorizing the execution of the School Resource Officer Agreement authorizing the assignment of eleven (11) School Resource Officers.

The School Board of Broward County and the City of Hollywood desire to add an additional School Resource Officer as more specifically set forth in the First Amendment to Agreement. The School Board intends to defray a fraction of the City's cost toward the City's School Resource Officer Program by reimbursing the City of Hollywood in the amount of \$32,376.40, which is \$4,625.20 per month for 7 months.

The City shall make appropriate pro rata reductions in the amount invoiced during any month in which circumstances reduced the amount of SRO service provided by the City.
