On October 3, 2012, via resolution R-2012-306, the City entered into a lease agreement with The Community Enhancement Collaboration, Inc. (CEC) for the provision of community services to the residents of the Washington Park, and this Lease Agreement expired on November 19, 2017.

The attached new Lease Agreement with CEC provides for a lease term of five years with the option to renew for one additional five year term. The rental payment for this lease agreement is one dollar (\$1.00) per year.

If the City is required to pay property taxes, CEC will be responsible for the expense. Previously grant funding was used to pay utilities but funding is no longer available; therefore, the City will pay the utilities for six months, and after six months the tenant will be responsible. The funding for six months' of utilities expenses is available in the Public Works FY 2018 Operating Budget.
