These helmets are for new Members of the Field Force Team and Members needing larger helmets. These helmets have the ability to protect the Field Force Team Members from objects striking them. 55 Chest and Back Protectors. These are will protect Members from the collarbone to the waistline in the front and from the shoulder blades to the waistline in the rear. The outer shell is made of super high impact ABS moulded shell. The inside is composed of low-density impact absorbing polyethylene moulded foam that reduces weight and allows circulation of air around the product. 55 Shoulder and Upper Arm Guards composed of an outer shell that is made of super high

These gloves are waterproof, have an anti-cut insert lining, hard shell knuckle and handback protectors, fireproof stitching thread and fireproof male and female velcro, shock absorbing protectors (foam and jelly) on fingers, thumb, and wrist, and roller buckle closure with leather strap at wrist for secure fit. 55 Public Order 24 inch Riot Batons with a solid nylon with rubber molded grip, retaining strap, and locating ring. 50 Scorpion Lightweight, full length personal protective shields. 5 (varying in sizes) Fully Body Fire Retardant suits, in separate pieces. 4. Detailed description of the products/services function and purpose. Riot Gear Helmets with Thermoplastic shells, Chest and Back Protectors with made with super high impact ABS moulded shells and low-density impact absorbing polyethylene moulded foam that reduces weight and allows circulation of air around the product, Shoulder and Upper Arm Protectors made with super high impact ABS moulded shells and low-density impact absorbing polyethylene moulded foam that reduces weight and allows circulation of air around the product, leather Riot Protection Gloves that are waterproof, fireproof, and provide shock absorbing features as well as hard shell knuckle and handback protection, 24 inch Riot Batons made of solid nylon with rubber molded grips, retaining straps, and locating rings, Full Sized Protective Shields (5 foot tall) featuring a bend in the top section to avoid the blade of the shield to direct towards the face/head of the user and a return on the edge of the bottom to deflect impacts and help protect from angled impacts as well, and Fire Retardant suits that can be utilized to protect the entire body of the user against flames. The recent last few years has brought a multitude of challenges for law enforcement. Civil Disturbances have become the median to which society voices their complaints about various issues and these Civil Disturbances not only have become more violent from those participating but have also become "soft targets" for terrorists both domestic and foreign. We have seen in Virginia how a single person in a vehicle can easily kill/injure numerous people in mere seconds, how protests in Washington DC, Berkley, CA, New York City, and other parts of the country have gotten out of hand because of poor police tactics or equipment causing violence, injuries, damage to property, and lack of civil order. We have also seen these same circumstances in other areas of the world, most recently Europe and Iran. In these civil disturbances abroad the protestors, for the most part, are demonstrating against dissatisfaction of the government, something often seen in the country, especially in the last year with the current Federal Administration. Something that will only continue and presumably will become more frequent and violent. We have seen the maturation of special interest groups such as Antifa, Anonymous, and Black Lives Matter become more bolden in their expression of their 1st Amendment Rights, often resorting to violence during their demonstrations along with disruption of civil order in our communities. We, here in Hollywood, have seen the issues of racial tensions here at our own City Hall where protestors from both sides have gathered to voice their opinions on streets named after historical figures with controversial lives. We have seen each time how not only are there people there to protest and issue, but there are groups that oppose eachother as well and often clash when in the same area. The situation at our City Hall came to a boiling point on a few occasions. In two of them several arrests were made, Officers stood between large groups of protestors to prevent violence, and a single protestor from one side even attempted to attack his counterparts with a large flag pole, trying to use it as a joust to impale another human being. The City of Hollywood is on the forefront of national issues and is in great need of the Field Force Team to protect citizens, property, and the demonstrators 1st Amendment Rights to voice their opinions. The need for proper and up-to-date equipment is paramount for us to successfully achieve our goals as a Police Department to keep the peace. The constant struggle to maintain current in law, tactics, and practices never ceases, current equipment is the same. The modernization, not militarization, of law enforcement equipment will help the Hollywood Police remain current in today's ever changing dynamic society. The issuance of the above equipment will greatly increase our ability to handle Civil Disturbances resulting in a peaceful statement of opinion rather than injury, property damage, liability to the City of Hollywood and it's Police, and negative headlines in the media nationwide.

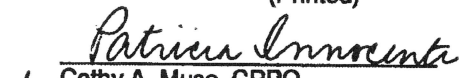
