

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH BROWARD COUNTY REGARDING THE SIX CENTS LOCAL OPTION GAS TAX.

WHEREAS, Broward County has adopted by Ordinance a Local Option Gas Tax; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the funds collected is shared with units of local government within Broward County based on population; and

WHEREAS, the current Interlocal Agreement ("ILA") with Broward County for the "original" six cents local option gas tax expires on August 31, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the attached Interlocal Agreement provides for the distribution of gas taxes among the Cities based on population figures published annually by the University of Florida Bureau of Economics and Business Research; and

WHEREAS, the distribution to Broward County is 62.5% and the amount distributed among the Cities based on population is 37.5%; and

WHEREAS, the current method of distribution is inequitable because it takes only residents into consideration, not the actual usage of roadways by travelers working in and visiting the City; and

WHEREAS, the distribution of Local Option Gas Taxes should be re-evaluated to accurately reflect usage of city streets, number of collector miles, and cost of maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Financial Services and the City Attorney have reviewed the Interlocal Agreement with Broward County regarding the Local Option Gas Tax.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of the attached ILA between Broward County and the City of Hollywood, providing for the division and distribution of the proceeds of the Local Option Gas Tax imposed by the Broward County Local Option Gas Tax Ordinance, together with such non-material changes as may be agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That the City of Hollywood recommends that the distribution of Local Option Gas Taxes be re-evaluated to accurately reflect usage of city streets, number of collector miles, and cost of maintenance.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
