("BDG").

## Explanation:

This Resolution seeks approval of a settlement agreement regarding the ICON property.
The total cost of the settlement is $\$ 1.5$ million and the City and the CRA have agreed to share the cost. The terms of the settlement are as follows:

- $\$ 500,000.00$ upon execution of the Settlement Agreement;
- $\$ 500,000.00$ upon obtaining a No Further Action with Controls from the Broward County Environmental Protection and Growth Management Department ("EPGMD"); and
- $\$ 500,000.00$ upon completion of construction of the Icon Office Building.

The City's portion of the funding has been set aside in the reserves of the Self-Insurance Fund. Additionally, the City and the CRA will be responsible for securing environmental liability insurance for the Icon property. The cost of which is unknown but will be requested as part of the City's Self-Insurance Operating Budget.
