WHEREAS, as of the solicitation due date, 67 potential vendors viewed the solicitation on BidSync; and

WHEREAS, F-4568-18-RL was opened at 3:00 p.m. on January 24, 2018, and resulted in the following responses:

WHEREAS, the submittal from Drew Fuel Services, Inc. was a no-bid response; and

WHEREAS, the bid results are as follows:

All Liquid Environmental Services LLC, D/B/A Johnson Environmental Services \$147,494.00 ; and

WHEREAS, Hinterland Group, Inc. has been determined to be the lowest responsive, responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, award is subject to the City's receipt and approval of all insurance certificates and endorsements required by the City's Risk Manager, and indemnity to the City; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Utilities and the Director of Procurement & Contract Compliance recommend that the City Commission issue the attached Blanket Purchase Order to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, Hinterland Group, Inc. of Cocoa, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the term of the Agreement shall be for an initial three year period, and may be renewed for two additional one year renewal periods; and
