# **Explanation:**

This Resolution seeks authorization for the appropriate City officials to enter into and execute a LED Lighting Agreement with the Florida Power & Light Company for the conversion of 5,788 currently existing FPL-owned and maintained street lights to LED lighting from high-pressure sodium vapor lighting. There is no upfront conversion costs to the City to migrate from high-pressure sodium vapor lighting to light-emitting diode (LED) lighting. Further, it is anticipated that a cost savings of approximately \$13,000 annually in street lighting electrical charges can be achieved due to the increased energy efficiency of the LED lighting and the decreased energy consumption to operate the streetlights.
