A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH BROWARD COUNTY FOR COMMUNITY BUS SERVICE TO REDUCE SERVICE HOURS AND CORRESPONDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AS A RESULT OF UNDERPERFORMING ROUTES.

WHEREAS, on April 20, 2016, the City Commission approved R-2016-102, which authorized the execution of an Interlocal Agreement with Broward County ("County") for financial assistance for several Community Bus Service Routes; and

WHEREAS, the County, pursuant to Article 5, Section 5.1 of the Interlocal Agreement, extended the term of this Agreement for a one-year period from October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into a First Amendment modifying the Agreement to reduce the service hours and funding for existing routes and allowing the County to modify and/or terminate financial assistance for underperforming Community Bus Service Routes; and

WHEREAS, Broward County Transit ("BCT") provides funding for local public transit service in the approximate amount of \$10,800.00 per month (\$15.00 per service hour per route, based on three routes); and

WHEREAS, two of these routes (Hollywood – Beach Line and North Downtown Line) are underperforming and funding associated with these routes will be reduced; and

WHEREAS, funding assistance shall be reduced from \$159,900.00 to \$78,146.25.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>: That it ratifies the First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement with Broward County for Community Bus Service – Financial Assistance Only. A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH BROWARD COUNTY FOR COMMUNITY BUS SERVICE TO REDUCE SERVICE HOURS AND CORRESPONDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AS A RESULT OF UNDERPERFORMING ROUTES.

<u>Section 3</u>: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
