A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FLORIDA. **APPROVING** HOLLYWOOD, AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE ATTACHED MEMORANDUM THE OF **UNDERSTANDING** WITH THE **HOLLYWOOD** PROFESSIONAL FIRE FIGHTERS, LOCAL #1375, IAFF ("IAFF") TO ADDRESS ARTICLE 6 (WAGES), ARTICLE 28 (PENSION PLANS) AND ARTICLE 31 (LIFE AND HEALTH GROUP BENEFIT PLAN) PRIOR TO THE CONCLUSION OF A NEGOTIATED SUCCESSOR AGREEMENT AND NOT BE DELAYED BY THE PENDING UNFAIR LABOR PRACTICE CASE NO. CR-2017-002 FILED BY THE IAFF.

WHEREAS, the City and the IAFF are parties to a collective bargaining agreement ("CBA") for the period from October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the City and the IAFF are in the process of negotiating a successor collective bargaining agreement; and

WHEREAS, the IAFF filed an unfair labor practice against the City, Public Employees Relations Commission ("PERC") Case No. CR-2017-002, contesting the City's declaration of financial urgency and unilateral reduction of pay and pension benefits, and that case is ongoing; and

WHEREAS, the final order in Case No. CR-2017-002 is not expected to be issued for several months and may affect the benefits of bargaining unit members and the cost to the City; and

WHEREAS, the decision in Case No. CR-2017-002 may affect the parties' positions concerning negotiations for a successor CBA; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to address Article 6 (Wages), Article 28 (Pension Plans) and Article 31 (Life and Health Group Benefit Plan) prior to the conclusion of a negotiated successor agreement and not be delayed by the pending PERC case.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of the attached Memorandum of Understanding with the Hollywood Professional Fire Fighters, Local #1375, IAFF, together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
