#### **Proposed Legislation:**

#### **Explanation:**

This Resolution seeks authorization to execute the agreement with the Hollywood Professional Fire Fighters, Local #1375, IAFF which allows all members of the Fire bargaining unit to receive a three percent (3%) across the board wage increase effective October 1, 2017. Funding for the wage increase is available in the Fire-Rescue Department's FY 2018 Operating Budget.

Additionally, this agreement allows for reductions in employee premiums paid for dependent medical coverage from the date of the execution of the MOU through the end of FY 2018. This reduction in premiums will reduce the expected revenue in the Self Insurance Fund for FY 2018.
