Explanation:

This Resolution seeks authorization for the appropriate City Officials to accept the Areawide Council on Aging of Broward County, Inc. grant in the amount of \$228,000.00. It further authorizes the appropriate City Officials to execute the attached Local Service Programs Contract, Memorandum of Understanding and any other applicable Grant Documents and Agreements.

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Since 2001 the State of Florida has awarded the City of Hollywood grant funding through the Department of Elder Affairs on a reoccurring annual basis. These sources assist the city in providing senior citizens with additional cultural, educational, and recreational services.

Funding is provided in the attached Exhibit 1 which, if approved, will amend the Fiscal Year 2018 Operating Budget adopted on September 27, 2017 via Resolution R-2017-288.
