SUBJECT: Proposed Blanket Purchase Order with Thompson Consulting Services, LLC

I have discussed the above Agreement with the participating Department/Office, and the proposed general business terms and other significant provisions are as follows:

- 1) Department/Division involved – Public Works
 - 2) Type of Agreement – Blanket Purchase Order
 - 3) Method of Procurement (RFP, bid, etc.) – Section 38.40 (C)(5) of the Purchasing Ordinance allows the Director to procure, without following formal procedures, all goods and services which are subject of contracts with the state, its political subdivisions, the United States government, other governmental entities, or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof, provided however, the goods and services are: (i) the subject of a price schedule negotiated by the state or the United States government, or (ii) the subject of a contract with another governmental entity or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof, which contract is based strictly on competitive bids or competitive proposals and not on any preference.
 - 4) Term of Contract
 - a) initial – September 7, 2016 through September 6, 2019
 - b) renewals (if any) – Two additional one year renewals
 - c) who exercises option to renew – Mutual agreement of the parties
 - 5) Contract Amount – \$5,000,000.00
 - 6) Termination Rights – Either party may terminate for cause if the party in breach has not corrected the breach within 10 days written notice from the aggrieved party identifying the breach. City may terminate for no cause upon 30 days prior written notice.
 - 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements – Contractor shall comply with applicable City requirements.
 - 8) Scope of Services – Contractor shall provide Disaster Debris Monitoring Services which includes, without limitation, assistance in the preparation for a disaster, temporary debris management sites, oversight for road clearance and debris loading, provide field oversight functions, and facilitate communications with various federal and state agencies involved in the disaster recovery process.
 - 9) Other Significant Provisions – Competitively bid by the City of Fort Lauderdale (RFP No. 865-11764)
