- **SUBJECT:** Proposed First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement with Broward County for Household Hazardous Waste and Bulk Waste and Yard Waste Drop-Off Programs.

I have reviewed the above captioned agreement for form and legality. The general business terms and other significant provisions are as follows:

1) Department/Division involved – Public Works

2) Type of Agreement – First Amendment Interlocal Agreement (Original Agreement approved by Resolution No. R-2013-254)

3) Method of Procurement (RFP, bid, etc.) - Pursuant to Section 38.40(C)(8) of the City's Code of Ordinances, the City Commission may, when in the **best interests of the City**, **by a 5/7ths vote**, waive competitive bidding and competitive proposal requirements for the purchase of, and contracts for, supplies or services.

4) Term of Contract

a) initial – Original Contract was for 5 years expiring on 9/30/18. The First Amendment will extend the contract for one year.

b) renewals (if any) – Original agreement did not provide for renewals.

c) who exercises option to renew – Broward County has proposed to extend current Interlocal for a one year term

5) Contract Amount – Under the proposed First Amendment the fees are as follows: (a) the per capita fee for Household Hazardous Waste will increase from \$2.06 to \$2.12 which increases the annual amount from \$289,982.00 to \$298,428.00; and (b) the per capita fee for Residential Drop-Off of Bulk Trash and Yard Waste will increase from \$.52 to \$.54 which increases the annual amount from \$73,199.00 to \$76,015.00.

6) Termination rights – Either party can terminate without case by providing notice.

7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements - none.

8) Scope of Services – County will provide household hazardous waste, bulk trash and yard waste drop-off programs.

9) City's prior experience with Vendor (if any) - yes

10) Other significant provisions – Although the per capita fees will increase, the County's Residential Drop-off Program of Bulk Trash and Yard Waste disposal service to residents will be free of charge at permanent collection sites.
