Explanation:

This Resolution seeks authorization for the appropriate City Officials to execute the attached Authorization to Proceed for Work Order No. LH 18-03 with Lighthouse Utility Consulting, Inc. in the amount of \$115,566.00.

The City Commission has adopted resolutions committing the Department of Public Utilities to provide sewer services throughout the city. To provide these services the department finds it necessary to conduct a new retail rate study to determine how to adequately pay for the costs of the services. The last rate study was conducted in Fiscal Year 2013.

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The City has a Professional Services Agreement with Lighthouse Utility Consulting, Inc. approved and adopted by City Commission Resolution R-2015-250 on August 26, 2015 to provide consulting services with regard to various water and sewer rates, financial analysis and revenue projections.

Funding for the services will be provided through the amending of the Adopted Fiscal Year 2018 Capital Improvement Program, Resolution R-2017-289 adopted on September 27, 2018, as detailed in the attached Exhibit A.
