Explanation:

The 2007 Water System Master Plan included the need to implement a City-wide program to rehabilitate and upgrade sanitary sewer lift stations. This project is for Lift Station A-5. AECOM provides engineering services for the design, permitting, bidding, and construction services for the Lift Station A-5 Upgrade project.

The Department of Public Utilities advertised for bids and six bids were received. Initially, BDLM USA was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. However, during a preconstruction meeting it was determined that BDLM did not include the cost of all equipment and accessories. The City and BLDM have mutually agreed to terminate the proposed contract.

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It was determined that the Intercounty Engineering, Inc bid does includes the cost of all equipment and accessories and it was the second lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

Administration recommends awarding the contract for Life Station A-5 upgrade to Intercounty Engineering, Inc in the amount of \$997,356.

Funding for the purchase of the lift station project was included in the in the Fiscal Year 2018 Capital Improvement Program that was adopted on September 27, 2017 via Resolution R-2017-289 and is available in account number 42.4000.86871.536.046301.

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
