## **Proposed Legislation:**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 33.025 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT FUND; ALLOWING CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE FUND TO PURCHASE CREDITED SERVICE FOR PRIOR CITY SERVICE.

## **Explanation:**

This Resolution seeks to amend the City's Code of Ordinances pertaining to the Employee Retirement Fund to allow additional employees to purchase credited service for prior City service.

The buyback for credited service amount due from the employee would be 8% of the compensation received during the period of prior employment, plus a buy-back fee of 4%. These funds would be collected by the pension fund and any impact of additional employees participating in the pension plan would be determined by a pension actuary. An actuarial impact statement is required prior to second reading.
