Explanation:

This Resolution seeks authorization for the appropriate City Officials to execute the attached Parklet Revocable License with Rosforsam, Inc. dba Mickey Byrnes in the estimated amount of \$4,320.00 (\$8.00 per space).

On October 4, 2017 the Community Redevelopment Authority Board (CRA) adopted Resolution R-CRA-2017-40, directing CRA staff to implement a Parklet Pilot Program for a one year period in the Downtown CRA. On September 5, 2018 the CRA Board adopted Resolution R-CRA-2018-30, which set the rate and time frame for the Parklet Pilot Program, including approving the placement of Parklet Pilot Program at this location.

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The adoption of the resolution provides revenue for Parking Fund 46 and authorizes the commercial use of Public Right of Way.

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
