A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE ALL APPLICABLE GRANT DOCUMENTS AND AGREEMENTS REQUIRED TO ACCEPT THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT TRANSPORTATION SUBGRANT UNDER THE OF SAFETY OFFICE HIGHWAY SAFETY SUBGRANT PROGRAM TO CREATE AN INITIATIVE TO REDUCE TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS INVOLVING FATALITIES AND BY CONDUCTING DELIBERATE INJURIES ENFORCEMENT OPERATIONS TARGETING SPEED AND AGGRESSIVE DRIVING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$40,000.00; THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 ADOPTED AMENDING OPERATING BUDGET (R-2018-301) FOR THE POLICE GRANTS FUND (FUND 13).

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") awards subgrants to traffic safety partners that undertake priority area programs and activities to improve safety and reduce crashes, serious injuries, and fatalities; and

WHEREAS, subgrants are awarded to state and local safety-related agencies to assist in the development and implementation of programs in traffic safety priority areas, and funding for these subgrants are apportioned to states annually from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration according to a formula based on population and road miles; and

WHEREAS, on March 2, 2018, the City Commission approved Resolution R-2018-072, authorizing the Police Department to apply for and accept, if awarded, a subgrant from the FDOT State Safety Office Highway Safety Subgrant Program in the approximate amount of \$60,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department was awarded a subgrant in the amount of \$40,000.00, and it intends to utilize the subgrant funds to create an initiative to reduce traffic accidents involving fatalities and injuries by conducting deliberate enforcement operations targeting speed and aggressive driving.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>: That the appropriate City officials are authorized to execute all applicable grant documents and agreements in a form acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

<u>Section 3</u>: That it authorizes the Department of Financial Services to create certain accounts to recognize revenue and appropriate program funding.

<u>Section 4</u>: That these Amendments to the FY 2019 Operating Budget for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2018 and set forth in detail in the attached Exhibit "1" are adopted and authorized as Amendments to the Operating Budget of the Police Grants Fund (Fund 13) of the City of Hollywood, Florida, for the Fiscal Year 2019.

<u>Section 5</u>: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
