Explanation:

This Resolution seeks authorization and approval for the appropriate City officials to enter into and execute a funding agreement with Pinnacle at Peacefield, Ltd. to provide funding totaling \$578,000.00 in order to develop the Pinnacle at Peacefield Affordable Housing Project for senior residents of the City on Adams Street. The funding agreement would include Home Investment Partnership Program ("HOME") funding in the amount of \$84,000.00 and Neighborhood Stabilization 1 ("NSP-1") Program funding in the amount of \$350,000.00, both of which are federal programs, and an additional \$144,000.00 in funding from the City through an Interlocal Agreement with the Downtown Hollywood Community Redevelopment Agency. The Downtown CRA and the City have agreed to a loan arrangement whereby the Downtown CRA will loan to

the City said funds with the City to reimburse the Downtown CRA on or before June 30, 2025 or, if the Downtown CRA term is extended, by such date as it ceases to exist.

Funding is presently available in accounts #11.1500.60637.554.008461 for the HOME funding portion and #11.1500.54480.513.049225 for the NSP-1 funding portion. The balance of the funding needed, \$144,000.00, will become available subject to the approval by the City Commission of a companion agenda item which approves the Interlocal Agreement between the City and the Hollywood Community Redevelopment Agency.
