# Biography:

Debra Case was born in Burlington Vermont in 1957 and has worked in business management at various levels since high school. She began her professional career as a teenager working after school at Dunkin Donuts and later was hired to manage various retail businesses including Hathaway Shirt Company's retail outlet and Hickory Farms. While still in her twenties, after six years as an outlet manager, Debra was recruited by the Dunham Shoe Company in Brattleboro Vermont as a buyer and was responsible for a \$3M budget for 25 outlet stores throughout New England.

In 2000, Debra and her husband Terry moved to South Florida, a place far away from her home in Vermont. She immediately found a book keeping position at Ocean Alley Restaurant and Beach Bar on Hollywood's Broadwalk. Though the beach at that time, clearly infested with slum and blight, the beach showed tremendous potential and opportunities seem to abound. Debra soon became a well-known figure due to being president of the Hollywood Beach Business Association, joining city advisory committees, attending every related city commission and CRA board meeting, meeting regularly with the BCRA executive director, ex-officio member GHCC Board of Director and in 2013 was awarded the GHCC "Business Women of the Year". Her most significant accomplishment to date was being elected District 1 Commissioner, Hollywood Florida in November 2016.
