Explanation:

This Resolution seeks authorization for the appropriate City Officials to enter into and issue a blanket purchase order for annual occupational health services, specifically preplacement physical examinations, and complete physical examinations for members of the Fire Rescue Department's HazMat team as well as vaccinations, treatment and screenings for infectious diseases for the Fire Rescue, Police, Public Utilities and Public Works Departments.

Pursuant to Request for Proposals, "RFP", Number 4598-18-PB, a solicitation for the above described services was issued by the City on September 7, 2018 with a return date of October 4, 2018. The solicitation resulted in 2 responses which were evaluated by a selection committee. Upon the committee's evaluation of the responses, it was determined that the response submitted by Concentra Medical Centers in the amount of

\$69,440.00 for said services was the lowest, responsive and responsible bid. A recommendation was prepared by the committee to award the bid to Concentra Medical Centers. The agreement will be for a period of 3 fiscal years with an option to renew for 2 additional 1 year periods, if approved.
