- 1) Department/Division involved Public Utilities
- 2) Type of Agreement Blanket Purchase Order
- Ordinance allows the Director to procure, without following formal procedures, all goods and services which are subject of contracts with the state, its political subdivisions, the United States government, other governmental entities, or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof, provided however, the goods and services are: (i) the subject of a price schedule negotiated by the state or the United States government, or (ii) the subject of a contract with another governmental entity or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof, which contract is based strictly on competitive bids or competitive proposals and not on any preference.
- 4) Term of Contract
 - a) initial Three year term
 - b) renewals (if any) Two additional one year terms
 - c) who exercises option to renew Mutual agreement of the parties
- 5) Contract Amount \$135,000.00
- 6) Termination Rights City reserves the right to terminate in whole or part by giving written notice at least 30 days prior to the effective date of the termination.
- 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements Contractor shall comply with applicable City requirements.
- 8) Scope of Services Contractor shall provide pump and motor repair services.
- 9) Other Significant Provisions Competitively bid by Martin County (Solicitation No. RFB2018-3087)
